DofE Bronze Practice Camp & Qualifying Expedition

Practice Camp:

An overnight camp has been arranged for Bronze Duke of Edinburgh participants on Friday 14th - Saturday 15th June 2024. The purpose of this event is for the pupils to complete necessary training in preparation for their qualifying expedition. Attendance to all the training is necessary for your child to complete their qualifying expedition.

Pupils should arrive at school at 6pm, they will complete a number of training activities including cooking dinner and setting up camp on school site. They will then camp overnight and complete further training activities on Saturday morning. Pupils should be collected from school at I I am on Saturday 15th June.

Pupils will be required to wear appropriate outdoor clothing as explained in their training and bring all the equipment needed for their expedition. They will also need to bring appropriate food for their meals. Accommodation will be in tents and they will be camping with members of their group and will be supervised by Etone College staff.

Qualifying Expedition:

For their qualifying expedition, pupils will be travelling to Leicestershire by minibus in preparation to walk their planned routes departing on Monday 15th July and returning on Tuesday 16th July 2024. Pupils will need to arrive at school at 8am on Monday 15th July and should be collected from school at approximately 4:30pm on Tuesday 16th July.

Pupils will be required to wear appropriate walking gear as explained in their training and bring all the equipment needed for their overnight expedition. They will also need to bring appropriate food for their meals over the two days. Accommodation will be in tents, they will be camping with members of their group at Foxes Covert Campsite, Kirby Malory. Staff from Etone College will be on site supervising overnight. Etone College staff will be remotely monitoring pupils for the duration of the expeditions in accordance to the Duke of Edinburgh regulations.

There is no further cost for these events as fees have already been paid with the DofE enrolment.

Please complete the Microsoft form by Wednesday 22nd May 2024. Without the completed consent form, your child will not be allowed to participate in either event. Please also report any changes to your child's medical form held in school. https://forms.office.com/e/qAuax4rsgy
