YEAR 7

All pupils study German in the Summer term.

During the summer half-term, your child will receive a recommendation from their teacher about which language they should continue from Year 8 onwards.

YEAR 8

À loisir (Summer half term 1) and Le sport en direct (Summer half term 2)

This term your child will be continuing to develop their knowledge and understanding of the French language and culture by building on the foundations laid in Year 7.

Over the course of the term your child will learn:

- How to talk about TV programmes, film, technology, different hobbies, and music.
- How to arrange to go to the cinema in French
- How irregular adjectives work as well as recapping the rules of adjective agreement
- A range of prepositions in French
- How to use the immediate future tense
- How to talk in more depth about what sports you and others enjoy
- Use the regular verb 'jouer' and the correct preposition to talk in the 1st and 3rd person about what people play
- Use the irregular verb 'faire' and the correct preposition to talk in the 1st and 3rd person about what people do
- Use the comparative to say which sports you prefer and why
- Using three tenses together

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YEAR 9

Le monde Francophone (Summer half term 1) and Transition module (Summer half term 2)

This term your child will be continuing to develop their knowledge and understanding of the French language and culture by building on the foundations laid in Year 7 and 8.

Over the course of the term your child will learn:

- How to talk about holiday activities, the weather, accommodations, and modes of transport in French
- How to use regular -er, -ir, and -re verbs with accuracy to talk in the 1st person singular, 1st person plural, and the 3rd person singular
- How to give an extended opinion using reflexive verbs
- How to use the comparative and superlative
- How to use the regular and irregular past tense
- How to describe a dream holiday
- How to use four tenses together
- How to dictate in French
- How to describe a photo in French
