



### YEAR 7

Meine Familie und Freunde (Summer half term 1) and Freizeit – Juhu! (Summer half term 2)

This term your child will be continuing to develop their knowledge and understanding of the German language and culture by building on the foundations of learning laid in Key Stage 2.

Over the course of the term your child will learn:

- How to talk about their families and pets
- To use adjectives to describe someone's physical appearance
- To use adjectives to describe someone's personality and character
- How to use the irregular verbs 'haben' and 'sein'
- How to use regular verbs like 'spielen'
- How to use irregular verbs like 'gehen'
- How to give opinions that are justified
- How to talk about wider free-time activities and compare them to common German past-times
- Using the present tense with a time phrase to talk in the future

*During the summer half-term, your child will receive a recommendation from their teacher about which language they should continue from Year 8 onwards.*

### YEAR 8

Total vernetzt (Summer half term 1) and Wir gehen aus (Summer half term 2)

This term your child will be continuing to develop their knowledge and understanding of the German language and culture by building on the foundations laid in Year 7.

Over the course of the term your child will learn:

- How to talk about TV programmes, film, technology, different hobbies, and music.
- How to give an extended opinion using 'weil'
- Use the future tense to talk about what we will do in our spare time
- Using three tenses together
- To talk about what there is and isn't in their town
- To say what they can do in the town
- To describe their typical weekend in three tenses



## YEAR 9

Holidays (Summer half term 1) and Transition module (Summer half term 2)

This term your child will be continuing to develop their knowledge and understanding of the German language and culture by building on the foundations laid in Year 7 & 8.

Over the course of the term your child will learn:

- How to talk about holiday activities, the weather, accommodations
- How to give an extended opinion using 'weil'
- How to use the comparative and superlative
- How to use the regular and irregular past tense
- How to use wenn clauses with accuracy
- How to describe a dream holiday
- How to use four tenses together
- How to dictate in German
- How to describe a photo in German
