I am writing to confirm the arrangements for the remainder of your child's education in Year II at Etone College.

As of today, Tuesday 11th June, Year 11 pupils will only be required to attend school when they have an organised revision session or an examination, as per the table overleaf.

All pupils must wear full school uniform to all exams and revision sessions and pupils must be fully prepared with all equipment. Pupils must arrive at school at least 30 minutes before their exam or revision session is due to start and report to the Café to sign in. For example, on Friday 14th June, those pupils who have a Geography exam are to arrive in school at normal time and those pupils who only have a Science exam in the afternoon would arrive either at normal time to revise in school or at 11.15am for their science revision session.

Pupils completing exams will have the opportunity to be dismissed straight home when their exam finishes so that they can fully prepare for any other upcoming examinations. **Pupils must sign in and out from the Café.** Alternatively, they can stay on site for any planned revision sessions with teachers in school (as per the table overleaf).

On Friday 14th June 2024, where pupils have two exams, they will remain on site until the end of the examination. Following this examination, there will be refreshments and an opportunity for pupils to sign shirts.

On Wednesday 26th June, from 9.30am-II.I5am, we will be holding a leavers' assembly in the School Hall to celebrate your child's time here at Etone College. Pupils should arrive in the Café from 9.00am for breakfast rolls and refreshments. Leavers' hoodies will be distributed at breakfast to those pupils that have ordered one. Pupils are not required to wear uniform.

Donations of equipment, uniform, PE kit and revision guides that pupils/families are willing to donate to support others would be gratefully received. For more substantial donations, pupils will be rewarded with a Love2Shop/Odeon Cinema voucher as a small thank you.

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support and to wish your child the best of luck in their ongoing examinations and future plans. I look forward to seeing those who are attending the Prom on **Thursday 27**th **June 2023.**
