We are delighted to inform you that during the week of 15<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> July 2024, Key Stage 3 pupils at Etone College are taking part in an enrichment programme. The content of the programme is closely linked to our careers programme and will enable pupils to develop key employability skills. Pupils should arrive in full school uniform for 8.45am as normal. On days where pupils are taking part in PE they will be required to attend school wearing their PE kit and bring water, a hat and plenty of sun cream. Students will report to the astro turf area to register each day. Students will also watch a theatre performance by Salt Mine.
