

TIMETABLE FOR ETONE COLLEGE INDEPENDENT ADMISSION APPEALS FOR YEAR 7 - SEPTEMBER 2025 ENTRY

APPEAL APPLICATION

Appeal applications should be made in writing to the Clerk to the Appeals Panel at Etone College or by telephoning the school on 024 76 757300. Please ask for an Admission Appeals form. You must give written reasons for your appeal.

Once an appeal has been lodged, appellants will receive at least 10 working days' notice of their appeal hearing date (although appellants can waive their right to this).

If you would like to submit additional evidence prior to the appeal hearing, you should ensure that this is submitted to the Appeals Clerk at least 7 working days prior to the appeal hearing. Decision letters will be sent within 5 working days following the hearing.

ADMISSION APPEALS FOR CHILDREN DUE TO START SECONDARY SCHOOL IN SEPTEMBER 2025

National Offer Day (Secondary) – 1st March 2025 (or the next working day) **Deadline for Lodging Appeals** – 3pm on Friday 11th April 2025

Appeals received by Friday 11th April 2025 will be heard, on 22nd May 2025. These dates are subject to change.

Appeals received after Friday 11th April 2025 (late appeals) will be heard in July 2025, only where practicable, or within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged (whichever is later), where practicable.

Please note it may not be possible to hear late appeals before the start of the new school year in September 2025. Appeals are not heard during school holidays.

Mid-Year Admissions

If your child has been refused a place at one of your preferred schools outside the normal round of admissions (i.e. at any other time than as above), you may appeal. Your appeal, where possible, will be heard within 30 working days of being lodged. Mid-Year appeal applications should be made in writing to the Clerk to the Appeals Panel at Etone College or by telephoning the school on 024 76 757300.
