We are delighted to announce that we have the opportunity for year 13 students to attend a 'Grade Booster' workshop for A Level Psychology run by the organisation Tutor2U. The workshop takes place in Birmingham at The Vue cinema, Star City on Thursday 20th March 2025. It is an all day event from 10:30am until 3:15pm.

This workshop will be an opportunity for students to receive some expert tips for success for their Psychology A Level examinations in June. It is run by Psychology teachers, tutors and examiners with a wealth of knowledge in the field. As part of the day, students will compete in a series of competitions and engage in interactive tasks. They will also receive a number of revision workbooks and resources to kickstart their independent revision. It is an excellent opportunity to both consolidate and extend their psychological knowledge.

Students who attend will be expected to dress in line with the Sixth Form dress code and provide their own packed lunch.

The cost of this trip is £36 per student and should be paid electronically using Weduc. Due to limited spaces on the minibus, spaces will be given on a first come first served basis.
