Year 11 Mock Exams - Session 1 (14th October - 15th November)

I am writing to provide you with some information regarding the mock examinations that your child will sit during Year II. The dates of the mock examinations for Year II are as follows:

Mock Series I	14th October 2024 – 15th November 2024
Mock Series 2	3rd March 2025 – 28th March 2025

As your child starts the final year of their GCSE course, it is vital that they are fully prepared for the exams in the summer. To support your child in their preparation, there are two sets of mocks for Year II. In the first set of mocks, pupils will sit examinations in all of their GCSE subjects with the equivalent number of papers in English and Maths that they will sit in the summer series. In all other subjects, pupils will be assessed on content taught. Pupils will be guided about what to revise in lessons and will receive an examination timetable in advance. In the second set of mocks, pupils will sit examinations equivalent to the summer series. Pupils will be supported in preparing for these mocks through:

- Assemblies on how to revise and manage exam stress
- A mock assembly providing all of the information about how the mock examinations are organised and expected conduct during exams
- A booklet for yourself and your child with top tips on revision and revision skills
- A Help Your Child Revise Evening for parents 25th September 2024 (online)
- Revision materials in lessons
- Intervention sessions
- Curriculum information on the website (<u>HERE</u>)

Pupils will be given information about the knowledge and skills required, the success criteria and the topics to revise in lessons and this will also be discussed at our upcoming Year 11 Progress Evening on the 19th September. All of this information is provided in order to help them succeed and to help them to focus their revision. Staff will advise pupils of additional revision resources, including online platforms, that they can access to support their preparation.
