Dear Parents/Carers

Etone College has a positive behaviour policy where pupils and students will be rewarded for outstanding attainment and excellent behaviour, demonstrating the Etone Values and Employability Skills. This promotes a culture of healthy competition, achievement and celebrating success.

We are currently rewarding and celebrating our pupils in the following ways:

Weekly Celebrations

Lunch time raffles

Pupils who achieve 100% attendance and punctuality along with 0 negative points each week will go into a year group draw at lunchtime for chocolates.

Value of the half term certificates – pupil of the week

Form tutors select a pupil each week to be awarded a value of the half term certificate. These pupils will be entered into a prize draw each half term.

Monthly Rewards and Celebrations

Department Pupil of the Month

From December curriculum leaders will nominate a pupil of the month for each Key Stage. Pupils and students will be sent a Praise Postcard home and receive a prize.

Termly Rewards and Celebrations

Rewards and celebrations – Progress Praise

After each progress report curriculum leaders will use data to reward pupils in each year group for:

- Most Progress
- Highest Attainment

Pastoral Leaders will use data to reward

- Outstanding Behaviour – 100% Positive behaviour
- Excellent Behaviour – 95% Positive behaviour
- Outstanding Attendance - 100%
- House Points – Bronze (150 House Points)
- House Points – Silver (300 House Points)
- House Points – Gold (500 House Points)
- House Points - Head Teacher Silver (600 House Points)
- House Points - Head Teacher Gold (750 House Points)
- Student Leader - outstanding contribution (1 per student leadership role)



- Demonstrating Employability Skills
- Reading Awards
- HOH – Pupil of the term (1 per house for each year)
- SLT – Pupil of the term (1 per house for each year)

All pupils will receive certificates and badges where relevant. They will also be entered into prize draws. A first, second and third place will be drawn for each year group.

- 1st prize - £50 Amazon voucher for the pupil and £50 Just Eat voucher for the family
- 2nd prize - £50 Amazon voucher for the pupil and £25 Just Eat voucher for the family
- 3rd prize - £50 Amazon voucher for the pupil

Attendance and behaviour focus reward trips and experiences

These opportunities are available to pupils who show excellent behaviour, attendance and punctuality.

Platinum

At least 95% behaviour ratio and above, along with 97% attendance and 0 lates during the qualification period.

Gold

At least 85 – 94% behaviour ratio and above, along with 97% attendance and 0 lates during the qualification period.

Platinum Trip - Fully funded Bowling and Pizza at DiscoBowl Nuneaton

Gold experience - In school pizza and cinema experience

These places will be limited, therefore the qualification criteria is the minimum expected standard.

Places will be allocated to pupils with the highest behaviour and attendance scores first. The qualification period for these opportunities runs from Tuesday 26th November until Tuesday 14th January. This was launched to pupils through form time and lunch time announcements this week.
